Welcome to Summer Discover 2022! Below is valuable information that you'll need before you come to camp. The goal for Summer Discover is to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for everyone. CORE, the camp's largest population, spend their mornings in their chosen career activities. Afternoons are for sports and recreation.

On the first day

Please be sure to check-in at the registration desk if you have questions and then pick up your camp t-shirt.

Attendance

Dismissals

All early dismissals take place from the nurse's office which is located at the main entrance of the school. If you need to dismiss your child early, please fill out a dismissal from or e-mail the camp office. Campers will not be allowed to leave camp early without written authorization by a parent or guardian.

Drop Off & Pick Up

CORE campers are dropped off at the East Side Room entrance (Loring Arena side) of the building no earlier than 8:15 a.m. All CORE campers are picked up at the Winter Street entrance (pool end) no late than 3:30 p.m. for Session 1 and 3:00 p.m. for Session 2. For families with both an INTRO and CORE camper, drop off both campers at the Winter Street entrance and pick up both campers at the East Side room entrance (Loring Arena side) of the building.

Extended Day

We offer extended day in the morning and in the afternoon. Extended day in the morning starts at 7:30 a.m. and includes a continental breakfast in the café. The cost is \$10; \$5 for additional siblings. Extended day in the afternoon runs until 4:45 p.m. and includes additional sports and recreation activities. The cost is \$20; \$10 for additional siblings. Drop off for the morning is at the Loring Arena side of the building. Pickup is at the Winter Street side of the building.

HEALTH SERVICES WHILE AT THE SUMMER DISCOVER

Care of Mildly III Children

All ill children are brought to the health office where they are assessed by the nurse. Parents are called to make final judgement as to whether they need to take their child home.

Emergency Procedures

The nurse is called with the location of injury to child/staff. Information obtained by the nurse includes condition of injury, level of consciousness, any severe bleeding. Call 911 if appropriate. Send appropriate personnel to injury site. Put in place to direct any emergency vehicle. Summer Discover Director will accompany the injured person and will take any health information to hospital. The nurse will call parents to meet their child at hospital.

Administrating Medications

In order for the nurse to administer any over the counter medications the parent must sign our medication permission form. Prescription drugs must be accompanied by a doctor's order and in a pharmacy labeled container. All prescribed medicines need to be delivered to the camp office prior to the start of camp by a parent/legal guardian. All medication is stored in the nurse's office in a locked cabinet. Refrigerated medication is kept in the health office refrigerator. All medication must be picked up by a parent/legal guardian at the end of each session.
