KEEFE TECH STUDENTS WIN WITH CAREER TECH SKILLS AT STATE SKILLSUSA CONTEST

FRAMINGHAM, MA – Keefe Regional Technical School students used their career technical skills to bring home gold, silver and bronze medals at the State SkillsUSA Conference, held at the Best Western Royal Plaza Hotel in Marlborough, MA and Blackstone Valley Regional Vocational Technical High School in Upton, MA from April 27-29, 2017.

A total 2,300 students from 51 regional technical schools in Massachusetts participated in skills and leadership competitions in their career technical areas. Keefe Tech students competed in skill areas such as Robotics, Cosmetology, First Aid, and Web Design.

SkillsUSA is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preparing high school and college students for careers in technical, trade, and skilled service occupations through local, state, and national programs. Keefe Tech's state level bronze medalists are Dylan Beckerman of Holliston for Information Technology, Samantha Phipps of Ashland and Andrew Hancock of Holliston for Web Design, Melissa Calvo Vides of Framingham and Viviana Cruz of Framingham for Nail Care and Hudson Bickford of Holliston for Extemporaneous Speaking.

Additionally, Kevin Luna-Torres of Ashland was elected as a SkillsUSA Massachusetts State Officer, and Hudson Bickford of Holliston was selected as a National SkillsUSA National Voting Delegate.

"It is outstanding that our students performed tremendously against some very good competition," said John Brochu, Director of Career and Technical Education at Keefe Tech. "It is a tribute to our teachers working with energetic, hard-working students who demonstrated their talents with their peers across the state," he added.



Hamilton gave us the tools necessary to troubleshoot the problems we encountered. We felt prepared for the competition," he noted.


