Extended Day

INTRO Camp

CORE Camp

CORE campers select two career explorations, one for each week, for each session. The mornings are spent in hands-on, project-based discovery. The afternoons are a potpourri of sports and recreation activities sure to keep anyone amused & active. Studio, where campers can explore their creative side with acting or singing, is offered as an alternative to sports and recreation.

AUTOMOTIVE -- Boys & girls will be introduced to automotive tools and fasteners, make and model identification, engine disassembly, tire rotations and On-Car fluid maintenance inspection.

BAKING -- Flour, sugar, butter and eggs are the foundation of a wide variety of delicious baked goods. Boys & girls will learn the basics of the bakery and insider tips and tricks that will make your sweets extra fun and yummy!

COMMERCIAL ARTS -- Boys & girls will create a variety of visual arts projects. Materials used range from fuse beads to paper mache to various art media.

COSMETOLOGY -- Boys & girls will have lots of fun while learning different techniques of hairstyling, manicuring as well as face and hand massage.

CULINARY ARTS -- A basic cooking experience for the budding young chef! Boys and girls will be introduced to different ways of building flavors in a variety of savory soups, meals and entrees which will be brought home every night.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY -- Boys & girls will get hands-on experience with some of the latest digital cameras and professional techniques, taking photos and learning how to download, save and print their pictures.

ELECTRICAL -- Boys & girls will learn basic wiring and lighting systems while building a unique take home project.

GRAPHIC ARTS -- Boys & girls will learn how to create and configure graphic images and text and make assorted printed products. Students will work with Mac computers and design with the Adobe Professional software, InDesign.

HORTICULTURE -- Boys & girls will learn how to grow and care for a variety of plants. They will work in our school gardens and greenhouse. Campers will harvest and eat plants, as well as bring plants home to continue their own gardens.

METALS -- Boys & girls will learn to safely bend and form steel along with welding the steel together while creating a fun take home project.

PASTRY MAKING -- Pies, scones and so much more...a fun filled experience for the pastry connoisseur.

PIPE DESIGN -- Boys & girls will learn basic skills of cutting, fitting and gluing PVC materials relevant to the plumbing industry while designing and creating a fun unique project.

ROBOTICS -- Boys & girls will learn basic mechanical assembly and soldering skills to complete a battery operated robot capable of several different missions.

SPORTS & RECREATION -- A variety of sports games for those who love to stay active all day.

ADVANCED CULINARY: This runs for One Week during the AFTERNOON ONLY. Boys & girls will apply their basic culinary skills and learn new advanced master chef skills to create meals and entrees, as well as, preparing and serving lunch to two family members or friends of their choice. *There is a \$40 fee pertaining to the additional material cost. (Going into 6th, 7th, and 8th grade)

ADVANCED AUTO: This runs for One Week during the AFTERNOON ONLY. Boys & girls will apply their basic mechanical skills in addition to learning new advanced skills related to more complex automotive tools, brake installation, tire rotation, fluid checks, among many more exciting skills. (Going into 6th, 7th, and 8th grade)
